## Grüner Veltliner Spiegel 2015

Feuersbrunn / Wagram/Austria



The Spiegel vineyard has besides loess also gravel and river rock deposits from the old Danube river as it was wild and forming the Wagram. This gives this wine yellow pear flavors, stone fruit, a light pineapple and mango tropical fruit touch, great structure and a very long well balance finish. The delicate creamy texture and lively but pleasant acidity making it a pure joy to drink.

Wonderful now, but also great aging potential.

**Serving Suggestion:** It fits to salads , smoked fish , spicy mushrooms as well as to any kind of pasta , vegetable dishes , white meat to fried fish to fresh cheeses .

## Spiegel:

The Spiegel vineyard marks the border to Kamptal, and like Rosenberg is one of the highest points in Wagram. Protected to the northwest by the high ridge of the Hengstberg, the gently terraced vineyard at approximately 350 meters above sea level is oriented towards the south and also exhibits, besides loam and loess, a high proportion of Danube gravel and weathered Gföhl gneiss in the soil.

“Apart from the different soils, Spiegel is not in a basin but rather on an elongated plateau with a cooler, airy microclimate. Here, the Gruner Veltliner and Blaufränkisch turn out very minerally, delicate and elegant. They have a higher acidity and are not least therefore particularly long-lived.”

Peachy notes are accentuated by a very floral, creamy touch of oak to create a very appetizing, inviting nose. The palate is more rounded, flanked by sonorous but subtle oak spice and gentle fruit with a core of freshness and life that comes together on the long, spicy finish.

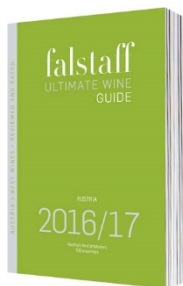
