A juicy, sweetly extracted core is elegantly wrapped in a harmonious veil of fine-grained tannin. The long finish features dark fruit and notes of gianduja. Dependable potential for further development and ageing.

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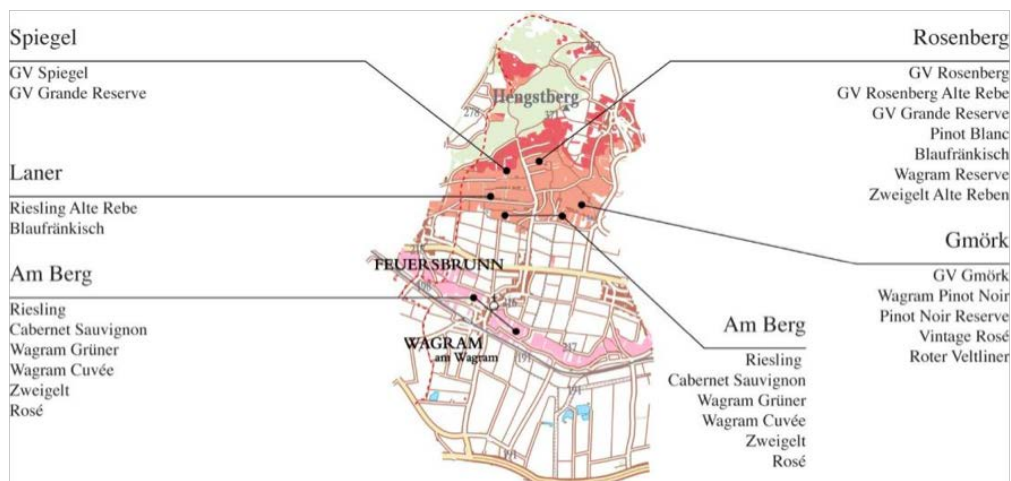
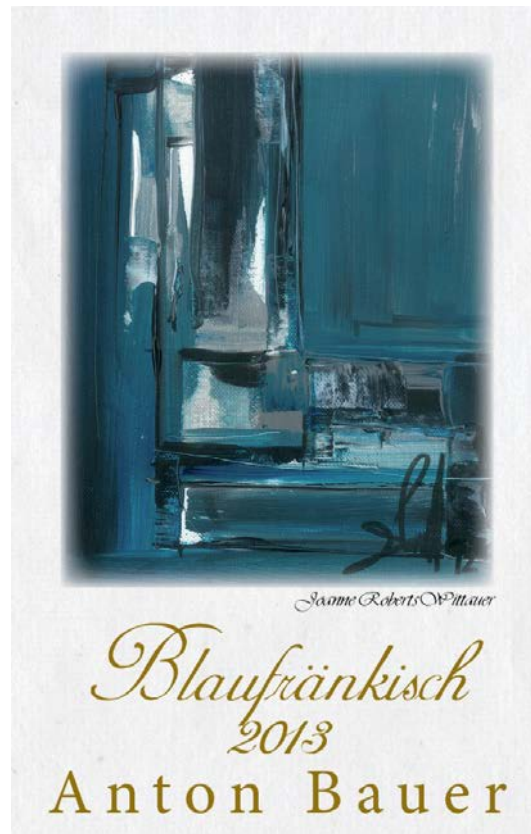


Blaufränkisch:
