Soil: deep loess **Vinification:** Stainless steel fermentation and ageing

Tasting Note: Very aromatic with lively violet, plum, mature sour cherry, pickled fruits and coffee bean aromas. Taste: Plum compote, clove, blackberry, light- to medium-bodied. Very clean, spicy and pure with fresh acidity through the finish. Reminiscent of a young Cru Beaujolais, only with more fruit, but dry because of a good acidity balance.

This wine drinks beautifully with a slight chill in the heat of the summer.
