the vineyard

100% Organic treatment, 5.000 - 7.200 vines
per ha, 3.500 - 4.500 kg/ha yield, gently
sloped, pruning done in January, harvest by
hand in second week of October.

wine production

100% destemmed, 20% saignée, temperature
controlled spontaneous fermentation with natural
yeasts for 4 - 5 weeks at 25°C, 1/3 new
barrique, 2/3 seasoned barrique for 18 months,
6 months bottle age

alcoholic content: 14%

total acidity: 5.8 g/l

residual sugar: 4.6 g/l

potential: ready to drink now, will hold on for
another 4 years

tasting notes:

Spice, fruit, and power. A dark ruby color with
purple rim, the nose shows a combination of fruit
and spice of blackberries, raspberries and
cherries underlined by black pepper. Topped up
with velvet flavor of cloves. The palate is
supported by delicate roasted aromas with
perfect harmonic integrated acidity. The discreet
wooden flavors support the perfect tannin
structure lasting in a long finish.

HILLSide Red 2019

This cuvée represents a perfect meeting of the minds between the spice of Syrah, the fruit of the Zweigelt and the power of Merlot.

With a dark ruby colour and a violet rim, its fruity, fleshy and spicy aromas evoke the perception of blackberries, raspberries and ripe cherries, as well as smoked meats & black pepper, with even a hint of clove joining the mix.

On the palate, especially the blackberry and black pepper come to the fore, coupled with fine roasted aromas and very well-integrated acidity.

The subtle use of wood contributes to the robust tannin structure and the long, concentrated finish.
