vineyard: The single vineyard Loisium is located directly behind our winery, around the Loisium Wine World (wine house & museum). „Steven Holl“ was the architect, who built the Loisium museum and the Loisium hotel.

age of vines: 10-30 years

harvest: harvest by hand, middle of October

fermentation: destemmed grapes, temperature controlled fermentation in tank by 17°C, selected yeast added

bottling: January 2021

aging: ~ 6 months in tank

alcoholic content: 13,5 vol. %

total acidity: 5,0 ‰

residual sugar: 3,8 g/l

potential: 2021 – 2030

ideal temperature to drink: 45–50 °F

tasting notes: Pale colour, flattering scents of fruits, mandarin, ranch, verbena, full bodied wine with lively acidity, soft mellow fruit and hints of nuts at the end.

food pairing: traditional Wiener Schnitzel of veal, in springtime good with white asparagus & sauce hollandaise
