vineyard:

The single vineyard Loisium is located directly behind our winery. The New York architect Steven Holl planed the Loisium Wine World in the middle of our vinyard. The label of the Grüner Veltliner Ried Loisium Kamptal Reserve shows the first blueprints of the wine project Loisium. In the middle you see the entrance building with the Loisium vinothek (grey), below the cellar labyrinth (red) and the Loisium Wine & Spa Hotel (yellow) above.

age of vines: 10-30 years
harvest: harvest by hand, middle of October

fermentation: destemmed grapes, temperature controlled, spontaneous fermentation

bottling: End of July 2022

alcoholic content: 13,5 vol.%

total acidity: 5.8 ‰

residual sugar: 3.5 g/l

potential: 2022 –2032

ideal temperature to drink: 45–50 °F

tasting notes: Dark and herbal aromatic, bark of a tree, walnut bread, black pepper, fine and well-balanced acidity, approachable and open in the glass with lovely fruity aromas of ripe lime, grapefruit, yellow cherries, powerfully built, substantial and elegant.

food pairing: traditional Wiener Schnitzel of veal, in springtime good with white asparagus & sauce hollandaise or other vegetable dishes with white meat
