Vineyards: 55 hectares

Varieties: 50% Grüner Veltliner, the remaining 50% is Riesling, Muskateller, Sauvignon Blanc, Traminer, Pinot Blanc, Zweigelt, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

Wine Region Kamptal: The name Kamptal refers to the Kamp river. This beautiful area is filled with culture and tourism, which are enhanced by the numerous Heurigen, wine taverns and Vinotheques. Karl Steininger is one of the initiators of the Loisium. The wineproject is nestled in the vineyards of Winery Steininger. Wine Village Langenlois: The family-run winery is situated in Austria's biggest wine growing village, Langenlois, the heart of the Kamptal.

Soil and Climate: Loess with gravel. The dynamics between the hot, Pannonian plain in the east along with the cool Waldviertel to the northeast, interplay between hot days and cool nights. This confers great aromas and vigorous acidity to the grapes.

Production: Grüner Veltliner is the majority of the production. It can be found in different styles, from a light summer wine to powerful and voluminous full-bodied wines as well as dessert wines and our speciality - the sparkling wines - which are produced according to the traditional bottle fermenting method.
