The "Scheurebe" is a cross of Riesling and, presumably, an unknown, wild variety developed by Dr. Scheu in 1916. This golden, yellow-colored wine has a fine, strong bouquet. Aromas of wild flowers, peaches and other stone fruits jump out at you, balanced by wonderful acidity building your palate up to enjoy the fruit flavors and ending in a clean, crisp dry finish. What an experience!
