BERGDISTEL Grüner Veltliner Smaragd® 2013

Shrouded in legend and in its light-blue splendor, the collegiate church of Dürnstein perches on a massive rock right next to the Danube. The renovation of the pen we owe the former priest of Dürnstein Prof. Distelberger. In his honor, and that bell tower, which is a symbol of Wachau Valley, this wine was grown. Prof. Adolf Distelberger (1930 - 2003) was also the inspiration and godfather for this wine. Symbolic for the comprehensive Wachau Valley, the grape for this wine grows in the most individual crus. The lime-loving plant Bergdistel and the reverse name of its godfather stand here as a synonym for Weissenkirchner and Dürnstener vineyards, which is completing the wordplay.

The combination of coolness, maturity and vitality of this Grüner Veltliner finishes in a shining elegance and full of finesse!
