The 2020 Dürnstein Grüner Veltliner Federspiel opens very clear, fresh and bright on the nose that displays refreshing white fruit as well as spicy, earthy aromas. Light but with juicy fruit and stimulating, piquant acidity, this is a very attractive, structured and persistently intense Veltliner from 23 different vineyards south of the railway, where the vines root in alluvial soils. 12.4% alcohol. Tasted at the domain in June 2021.

The Dürnstein 2020 Ried Superin Grüner Veltliner Federspiel opens with an intensely aromatic yet also pure and flinty bouquet and reveals lovely depth and character. Due to hail, the yields were 50% less than normal and gave a stunningly concentrated but light and stimulating Federspiel bottled with 11.8% alcohol. Lush and round on the palate, this is an intense and juicy, well-structured and persistent Veltliner with intense and aromatic fruit. It has ripe pear and plummy aromas on the aftertaste. Intense and immediately grippy on the palate, this is another mouth-filling, refreshing, mineral and persistently vivacious Veltliner with fine phenolic grip and piquant acidity. Grown on sand and loess but picked late, in early November, after the Smaragd wines, the resulting wine comes in with 11.5% alcohol, with malolactic fermentation included. The nose is deep and ripe but also fresh, slightly flinty and very elegant in its fruit expression. Finessed and refreshingly pure and mineral on the palate with a serious phenolic structure and food-friendly grip, this is an excellent, salty, piquant and tensioned Loibenberg with a long and stimulating finish. 14% alcohol.
